I have not participated in, or will not participate in representing the bank in those discussions or negotiations, for the performance of those. I have no personal interest in the contract. I will not be voting or participating in any deliberations involved in the ordinance or the contract that might be authorized for that.
- Commissioner Norcross moved to approve the ordinance providing for the issue of \$750,000 Taxable General Obligation Park Bonds, Series 2013, of the Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District, Ogle County, Illinois, and for the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest on said bonds.
